Prospering Farmers



We focus on a number of key enablers so farmers can improve their livelihoods through higher investment on farms and increased income. This is the difference your contribution made:

farmers benefited from our Farm Services activities below. Through our Farm Services, we provide farmers access to a farm diagnosis, planting materials, labor support and coaching to improve productivity and increase income.

2754

farmers received a Farm Business Plan. Based on a diagnosis of the farm by field staff, the farmer receives recommendations on how to increase the cocoa yield.

1233

farmers were supported with a Productivity Package. This consists of high quality agricultural inputs and individualized coaching services provided by field staff.

893

hectares of farmland were supported with preharvest interventions including pruning and input applications provided by trained labor teams.

farmers are above the poverty line (World Bank's International Extreme Poverty Line of 2.15 USD per day).

52030 cocoa seedlings were distributed.

Empowered Communities

We work to enable systemic and lasting change on child protection and human rights by strengthening our community-centric approach. Your contribution resulted in the following:

Associations. These community associations enable members to pool savings and raise resources to create their own business or fund household needs like school fees. Through financial independence, women are empowered to make decisions that affect their children and build resilience.

VSLAs. VSLAs are Village Savings and Loan

members of VSLAs are women.

cases of child labor were identified and 860 cases are being remediated. Remediation activities depend on the severity of the case and can include, among other activities, awareness-raising sessions, the distribution of school kits and the delivery of birth certificates.

children no longer in child labor.

Thriving Nature

We focus on ensuring deforestation due diligence and carbon removals through low carbon farming practices. Your commitment resulted in these achievements:

hectares of farmland are under management with agroforestry - where other crops are integrated with cocoa trees according to local geophysical and social conditions. The farms are monitored annually to track progress. The farmers receive a payment for their environmental services based on tree survival rates. Agroforestry also enables the reduction of pests and diseases, the promotion of biodiversity and an additional source of income for farmers while capturing carbon.

farmers delivered cocoa with all plots mapped. Farm mapping ensures no cocoa is coming from protected areas.


